**Albert W. Bowes**, 87, of the hamlet of Walkkill, died at home Thursday, Feb. 26, 2009. Born in New Rochelle, NY, Mr. Bowes was a life-long resident of White Plains and Somers until he moved to Walkkill six years ago. A veteran of World War II, he served in the Air Force in the Pacific.
